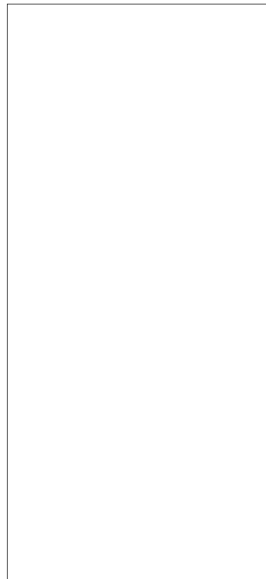

**WHAT IS THE  
NEIGHBORHOOD TOOL  
BANK?**



The Neighborhood Tool Bank is a community service that provides needed tools for gardening and cleanup projects for residents, neighborhood groups and organizations. It is intended to provide resources for environmental and beautification efforts in our community, in order to promote a true sense of neighborhood pride and empowerment.

**WHO OPERATES THE TOOL BANK?**

Comprehensive Community Solutions, Inc., a non-profit organization, operates the Tool Bank through its YouthBuild/AmeriCorps program. AmeriCorps members operate the Tool Bank, and can help you in your cleanup efforts as well.

**HOW DO I ACCESS THE TOOL BANK?**

The Tool Bank is located at 907 S. Main St. You can stop in 917 S. Main St. during the hours the Tool Bank is open, or call 963-6236 for information.

**WHEN IS THE TOOL BANK OPEN?**

*April 1st to September 30th*

**HOW LONG CAN I KEEP THE TOOLS?**

Tools may be kept for up to one week, however we request that they be returned as soon as your project is completed so that others may check them out.

**IS THERE A COST INVOLVED?**

No. The services and tools are free of charge.

**WHAT CAN I USE THE TOOLS FOR?**

Tools can be used by residents or neighborhood groups conducting clean-up, greening and/or community gardening projects.
